Acts 20:27 (ESV) — 27 for I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God.

Even though these truths were presented with tears and through trials, Paul still spoke up.

Acts 20:19-21 (ESV) — 19 serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials that happened to me through the plots of the Jews; 20 how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house
