

## Attention Summit Parents:

**Summit Servants' summer program** is back, but this time, we have a weeklong adventure planned for our young servants. Mark your calendars now for **Monday, July 29th through Friday, August 2nd**. Our program starts each day 9 AM and concludes at 4:30 PM. Early and late drop off can be arranged for parents who need extra morning and/or evening time for drop off/pick up.

We will start each day with prayer, a devotional and a life skill lesson prepared by several members of our congregation. Prepare to become an amazing servant by learning basic sewing, CPR and first aid, finance/budgeting, and how to assist people with disabilities. We will even learn how to help someone in need by changing their tire! In the afternoon, we will leave the building and serve the community by visiting the elderly, delivering surprises to our first responders and purchasing and delivering food to those in need. We also will have some games and crafts prepared by the Summit Teens.

This Summit Servant program is open to the children of the Summit Congregation ages seven and up. At the same time, **we will also provide a half day program for the younger Summit children ages three to six. The younger children's program will run from 9 AM to noon each day.**
