Time in prayer and Bible study plus active engagement in worship and a ministry of the church triggers growth in the roots that sustain us in Christ. When inevitable crisis comes into our lives, we need all our spiritual strength to overcome.

Job 37:14 *"Hear this, O Job; stop and consider the wondrous works of God."*
