Matthew 28:19-20 - Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name

of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

We refer to it as the Great Commission. The final recorded words of Jesus before his ascension into heaven. Jesus said to "go, make disciples, and baptize." 
PEOPLE WHO MAKE YOU BETTER By Andrew Ellis


