## **Do It Now!**

James 4:14 - Yet you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.

What is it that you have been meaning to do? What is that really important thing that you will do when you get around to it, or when you're not quite so busy. Maybe it's connecting with an old friend. Visiting an ailing grandparent. Letting a loved one know how much you care. Telling someone you're sorry or asking for forgiveness. Being baptized to walk in newness of life.

Novelist Fredrik Backman wrote "all people at root are time optimists. We always think there's enough time to do things with other people. Time to say things to them. And then something happens and then we stand there holding on to words like 'if.'"

God's word reminds us over and over again that we shouldn't wait, that we must act now. Jesus told the Parable of the Ten Bridesmaids in Matthew 25 to emphasize that we can't procrastinate and we must always be ready. Jesus says in Matthew 25:13, "Be on the alert then, for you do not know the day nor the hour." In John 9, Jesus tells us again that we shouldn't put things off, especially doing the work of the Lord and obeying God's word. He says in John 9:4, "We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming, when no one can work." James gives us the ultimate reminder that we don't know if tomorrow will ever come so we must act now. In James 4:13-14, James says, "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and

make a profit.' Yet you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are just a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away."

Do not wait until you have more time. Don't stand there holding on to "if." If it's important, do it now!

# A HIGHER PLAIN

Recently I hear a lot about "heart focused meditation" and its link to Christianity. The usual secular and eastern philosophy type of meditation causes the mind and the heart to wander. However, Christian meditation is from the heart and is focused.

When last did you spend even 10 minutes focused (from your heart) on all that God is doing for you. It's a simple exercise of breathing in through the nose for 4 counts and breathing out of the mouth for 6 counts while meditating, from the heart, on feelings of GRATITUDE, APPRECIATION, COMPASSION, and CARE. For instance: Thank you Lord for watching over one of our teens yesterday during the accident. I am so GRATEFUL and feel so blessed that you spared his life. Friend, if you have been raised with Christ, you should be seeking things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. You should be meditating on things above, not on things on this earth (Colossians 3:1–2 adapted).

When you join Jesus, on higher ground, things of this earth grow strangely dim in the light of His glory and grace. Doubts, temptation, fears, guilt, and anger slip away as you scale new heights and see His gentle face.

Friend, using your heart, scale the utmost heights so that you may: look upon His gentle face; feel His

meekness; experience His compassion; and become infused with the knowledge of His care.

Proverbs 3:16-17 "<sup>16</sup>Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. <sup>17</sup>Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace."


