HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

Honor your Mother and your Father, which is the first commandment with a promise. Eph 6:2

Today we honor our Mothers; whether you are blessed to have your mom still in your life or carry her in your heart. She has loved us unconditionally, doing without, so her children could have more.
